**Note:** Generic type Deck screws will not fit in Jig.

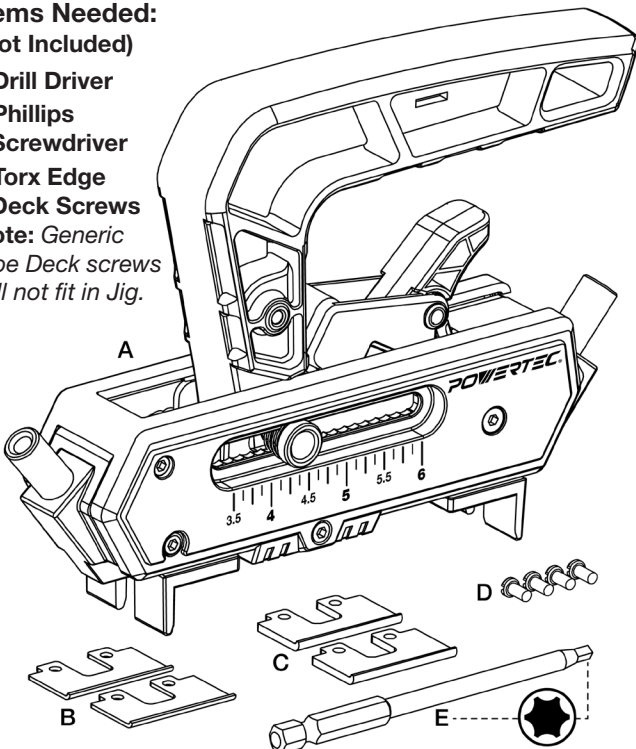


Figure 2 OPERATIONAL FEATURES

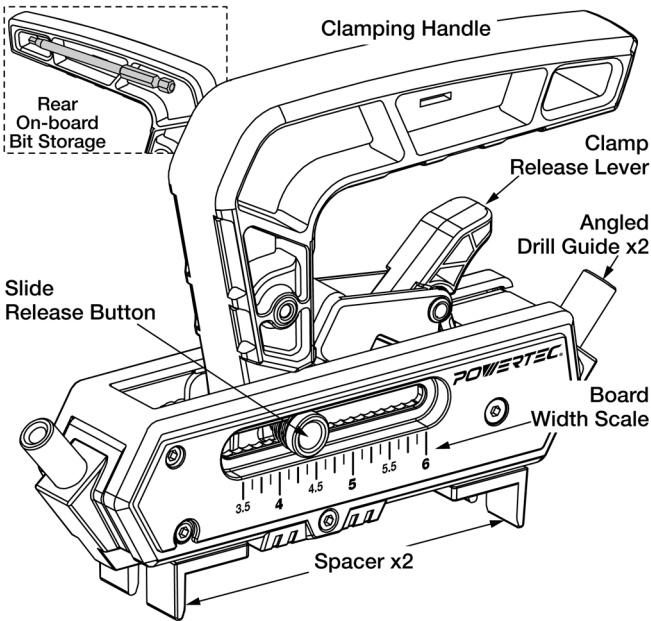


Figure 3 FIGURE CLAMPING WIDTH

Measure decking board.

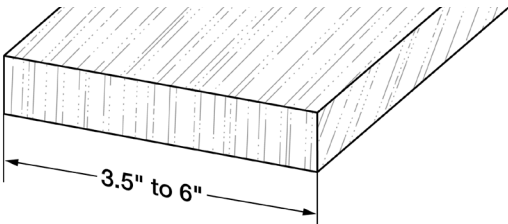


Figure 4 SET CLAMP WIDTH

Hold Handle while pressing Slide Release Button.

Move Button to nearest mark on scale—spacer jaws will expand—move until correct measurement is reached.

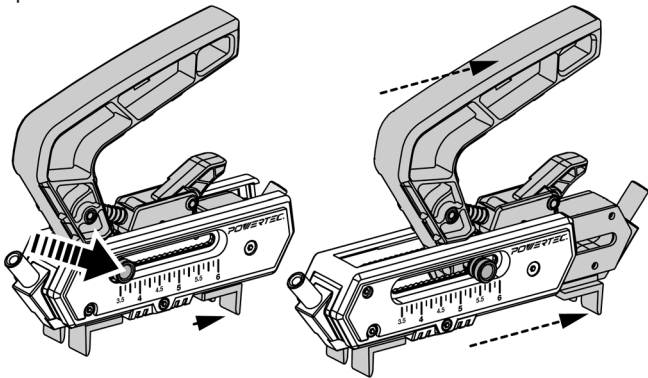
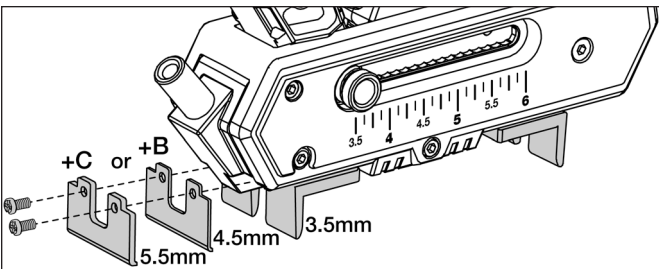


Figure 5 SET UP GAP SPACING

**3.5mm**—Default spacing—using fixed spacer on Jig.

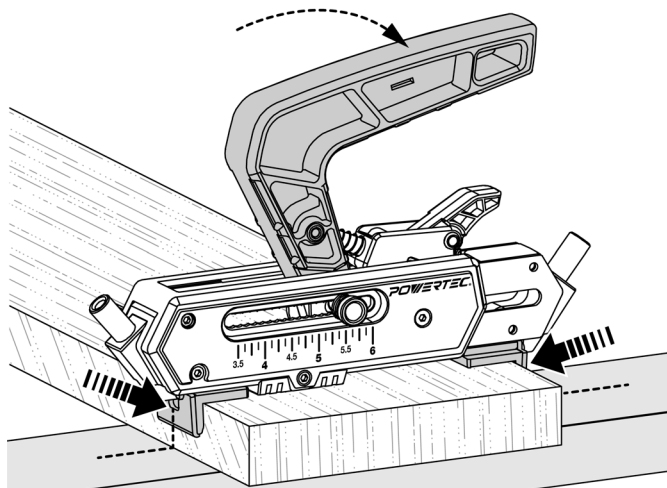
**4.5mm**—Add 1mm Spacer (B) on both sides to achieve this spacing.

**5.5mm**—Add 2mm Spacer (C) on both sides to achieve this spacing.



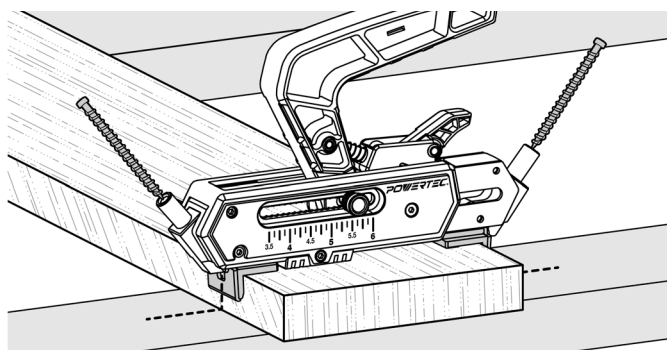
## Figure 6 CLAMP JIG TO BOARD

Push downward on Handle to clamp Jig to decking board ensuring the Clamp is centered on joist.



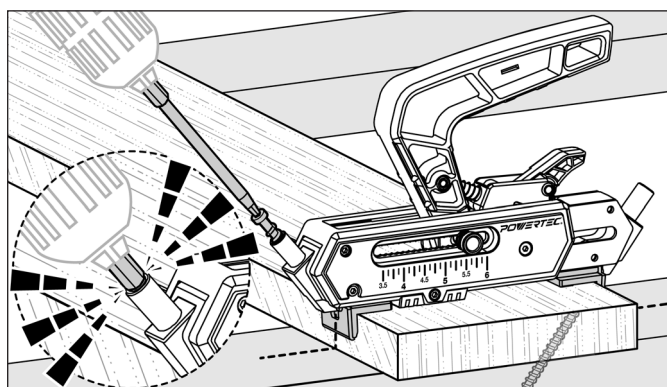
## Figure 7 DROP IN FASTENERS

Drop one screw into each Drill Guide.



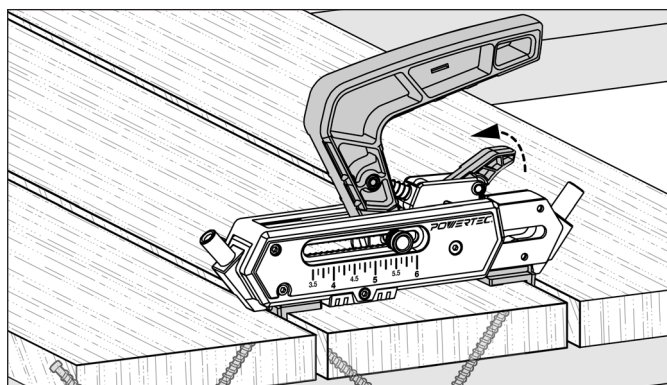
## Figure 8 SECURE DECK BOARD

Attach Driver Bit (E) to drill. Drive screw into board—stop when shoulder of Driver Bit makes contact with Drill Guide.



## Figure 9 RELEASE EDGE JIG

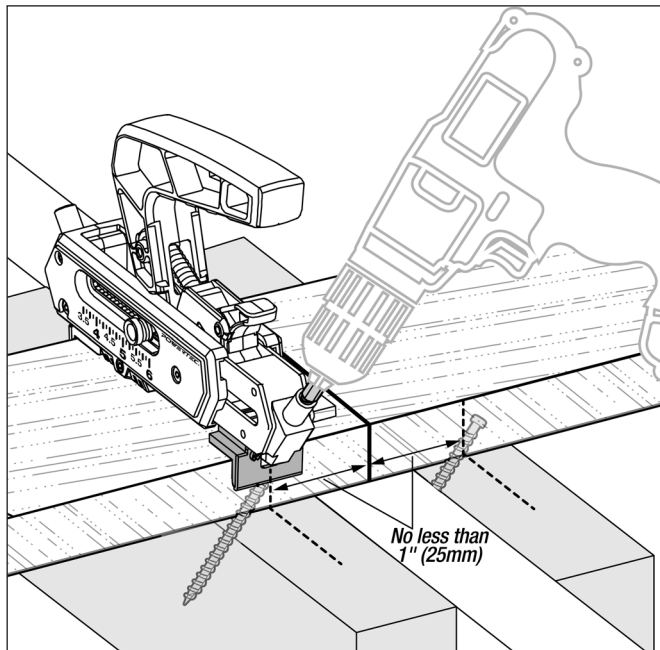
Release Jig by pulling up Clamp Release Lever.



## Figure 10 SECURE END/BUTT JOINT

When finishing an End/Butt joint, thicken the joist (if needed) to ensure the deck screw is located no less than 1" from the end of the board.

**NOTE:** Always center the Jig's Clamp in the center of the joist before fastening the board.
