





ASSEMBLY

- Insert 2 Set Screws (B), with rubber tip facing down, into the thread rings in the Fence. Thread the set screws until the screw tip aligns with the bottom of the thread ring.
- From the bottom of Fence, insert T-bolt (E) through the hole.
 Place Washer (D) and thread on Knob (C). Do not tighten at this time.
- Repeat to mount all the T-bolts, Washers and Knobs.

Attach Fence to Band Saw Table:

NOTE: The 72260 Fence is designed to work with and requires a Straight Edge Clamp, such as POWERTEC Contractor Straight Edge Clamp 71705 (24"), or similar product (sold separately), to attach to the table.


Slide T-bolts into slots of straight edge clamp (sold separately).


[1] Place Fence Assembly and Straight Edge Clamp onto band saw table.


- [2] Adjust Straight Edge Clamp to fit band saw table.

Using a Square, Set Band Saw Fence Perpendicular To Table Base.



If Fence is Leaning Right:


[1] Turn the 2 outer Knobs clockwise and stop when Fence is perpendicular to the band saw table at both ends of the Fence. Do not tighten at this time.

- [2] Use M3 Hex wrench (F) to fasten 2 set screws (B) until rubber tip is firmly against top of straight edge clamp.
- [3] Tighten the 2 outer Knobs.



If Fence is Leaning Left:


[1] Use M3 Hex Wrench (F) to thread clockwise the 2 Set Screws (B). Stop when Fence sets perpendicular to the band saw table at both ends of the Fence. Do not tighten at this time.



