

### To Install or Change Batteries (Not included):


Horizontal Plane

- 1. Turn off the Digital Angle Finder.
- 2. On the back of the device; Remove the cover.
- 3. Noting the polarity indicators; Install the batteries.
- 4. Replace the cover.
- 5. When storing; Always remove the batteries.


# To Turn ON Press the ON/OFF button once To Turn OFF Hold the ON/OFF button for 3 seconds When Idle If the Digital Angle Finder is idle for 5 minutes it will automatically turn off To Restart Press the ON/OFF button once

### **ZERO Button Function**


Pressing the ON/OFF button once will enter ABS Mode and act as a standard level. The angle shown is the angle to water level. The device will not ZERO in ABS Mode.



The ABS Mode measures the angle between the water table and the object being angled.




Pressing the ZERO button enters Relative Mode and establishes a horizontal plane. In Relative Mode the ABS icon will not appear and the angle between the established horizontal plane and object can be measured.




# To measure the difference between two settings:

two settings:
With the device on the
1st object in Relative
Mode, press ZERO
and the device will
enter ABS mode.
Press ZERO again
to set the 1st angle
as relative zero.
Place the device on
the 2nd object. The
difference between
the two angles will be
displayed.



To return to ABS Mode (Absolute Measurement) press ZERO one time. In ABS Mode the device will function as a standard level.



### To Calibrate

This Digital Angle Finder arrives factory calibrated. If in the event it has been dropped or joggled please use the following instructions to recalibrate the device.


Place the Digital Angle Finder on a smooth, level surface. Press the ON/OFF and ZERO buttons at the same time. This activates the calibration mode. "-1-" will be displayed.




Press ON/OFF button again. "-1-" will flash briefly on screen. Do not touch or move the device until "-2-" is displayed.



After "-2-" displays, rotate device 180° keeping in same location. Then press ON/OFF button again. "-2-" will flash briefly. Do not move until calibration is completed.



Calibration is now complete. The angle displayed on the Digital Angle Finder is the angle between the calibrated plane and the horizontal plane.



**Note:** Any reading on screen in ABS Mode shows the angle to water level.
